5 DAY PROGRAMME

School Center "Nikola Tesla", Vrsac, Serbia 13-17.07.2020.

During this week, a five-day program for 30 students who participated in the workshops in February and March was realized in the School Center "Nikola Tesla". Students had the opportunity to do and present their work and show how they applied the knowledge and skills acquired in the workshops. 10 students who attended the workshop on information technology presented their works on the project website mytes.upt.ro, while 20 students who attended the first part of the workshop on CNC programming presented their works live. Other students, who have applied to participate in the project, will present their work after the workshops.

Also, all the students attended career counseling sessions conducted by school associate Dragan Popov, school pedagogue and counselor in this project, with the help of Oana Omoran, a school psychologist. After the career counseling sessions, the students filled in the questionnaires from the Career Counseling Guide, which the counselor will analyze and statistically process in the following period.




